The Board of Directors is the leadership team for the Minnesota Fathers & Families Network and is charged with the overall governance of the organization. There are several fundamental expectations and responsibilities of those individuals serving as members of the Board.

EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF BOARD MEMBERS

Each member is expected to:

1. Have a strong belief in the mission of the Network and work toward the accomplishment of the Network's mission.
2. Approve, and amend as needed, the Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws and the financial policies.
3. Provide leadership to the staff in setting the direction for the Network and for establishing annual and long-term goals.
4. Establish Network policy governing the attainment of the mission and the operation of the organization.
5. Approve the annual budget for the organization. Monitor the financial operation of the Network and approve the financial statements.
6. Work with staff to ensure that there are adequate funds available to conduct the programs and implement the action plan for each year.
7. Serve on at least one committee of the Board.
8. Attend Board meetings on a regular basis.
9. Employ and evaluate the organization's Executive Director.
10. Make an annual financial contribution, of any amount, to support the programs of the Network.
11. Advocate for the Network and its programs and represent the Network throughout the state.
12. Ensure that the Network continues to qualify as a tax-exempt organization and complies with all state and federal regulatory requirements.

Our Mission:

Minnesota Fathers & Families Network enhances healthy father-child relationships by promoting initiatives that inform public policy and further develop the field of fatherhood practitioners statewide.

FINANCIAL AND TIME COMMITMENTS OF MFFN BOARD MEMBERS

It is recognized that Board members come from different socioeconomic levels. With this in mind, each Board member is expected to determine his/her capacity to contribute time, talent and financial resources to the Network.

Board members are asked to become dues-paying MFFN members (\$20.00 annual membership fee). In addition, each Board member is asked to make a personally significant annual financial donation of any amount. By making a personally significant annual donation, Board members will demonstrate to the public, the funders and other constituencies that the Board believes in, and supports, the programs of the Network.

As feasible and needed to enable participation at Network activities, the Network may reimburse Board members' travel expenses, such as mileage or lodging, within certain guidelines, as requested on a case-by-case basis.

Board members are asked to fulfill the following time commitments:

- **Attend quarterly day-long Board meetings**, normally held at locations across Minnesota on the second Mondays of March, June, September, and December. Overnight stays may be necessary, depending on the distance to each meeting's location. For example, recent meetings have been held in Brainerd, Cloquet, Hutchinson, Moorhead, Rochester, St. Cloud, and St. Paul.
- **Attend the Minnesota Fatherhood Summit**, the Network's annual winter conference.
- **Attend a New Board Member Orientation** at the start of the term.
- **Perform additional duties**, averaging 1-4 hours monthly, by tele-conference, e-mail, and small group meetings.
- **Faithfully serve for the duration of a 3-year term**, beginning in January.
